Enclosed for your information is a copy of the proposed report of the Chief of Engineers on the Los Angeles River Ecosystem Restoration Project, Los Angeles County, California. The project's integrated feasibility report, which includes the final environmental impact statement (FEIS) prepared in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA), is being filed with the Environmental Protection Agency and is being made available to interested parties for review and comment pursuant to regulations of the President's Council on Environmental Quality for implementing NEPA (40 CFR Parts 1500-1508). These documents are currently under review by the heads of Federal agencies and the Governor of the State of California. Upon receipt of their comments, the report of the Chief of Engineers will be finalized and submitted to the Secretary of the Army for transmittal to Congress.
