

CONSTRUCTION IN WATERCOURSE

10.2 General Conditions or Requirements for Watercourse Permit

Permittee's Obligations

A right of entry must be obtained by the Permittee if any of the work or means of constructing will require trespassing on private property not owned by the Permittee. This includes ingress and egress authority for either temporary construction or completion of any part of the work.

Information Required before a Permit for Construction in Watercourse

A Watercourse Permit requires hydrology and hydraulics calculations be prepared by a licensed Civil Engineer. A plan will also be required that shows alignment, elevations, and type of water conveying device. A review by the Geotechnical Division will be required as determined by the Engineer.
