5.7 Enforcement

In general, B-Permit requirements and conditions are enforced through the plan-check and inspection processes.

What is a violation?

- 1) Doing work without a permit
- 2) Performing operations that are not included in the permit
- 3) Failing to comply with provisions of the LAMC
- 4) Failing to comply with permit requirements
- 5) Failing to pay monthly B-Permit bills
- 6) Causing a deficit in B-Permit account by failing to pay cash balance due

How will violations be dealt with?

Failure to complete the B-Permit process could result in the failure to clear City Planning or building permit conditions, and may result in legal action. Failure to pay B-Permit deficits will cause the project to be placed on hold. Customers must keep their accounts from going into a deficit.
