The maintenance crew determines if the dissolved fluorescein passes through a downstream manhole, indicating a "Positive" Dye Test.</li> <li>A "Positive" Dye Test verifies that the property tested was connected to the City's Sewage System at the time the test was performed. However, the City can not verify the manners in which the property is connected.</li> <li>A "Negative" Dye Test indicates that the property tested was <b>not</b> connected to the City's Sewage System at the time the test was performed.
