PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND LOCATION:
 Application for the Smart Energy Transport System Project by WesPac Pipelines-LAX, LLC for a common carrier pipeline franchise to install, operate and maintain a pipeline within the City of Los Angeles. The application is for Phase I of the project in the City of Los Angeles. Within the City of Los Angeles, Phase I lies entirely within the Fifteenth Council District. The proposed pipeline would be a 16-inch diameter pipeline occupying 7,650 linear feet (1.4 miles) of the City's right-of-way. WesPac's pipeline would connect an existing storage facility at the Vopak Terminal in the Wilmington area of the City to an existing Kinder Morgan Watson Pump Station located in the City of Carson, traveling a total distance of 6.5 miles, of which 1.4 miles lie within the City.
